SCOPE OF WORK

The Veterinarian is expected to:

1. Conduct regular health examination of all captive animals at the PAWB-WRC;
2. Conduct regular deworming and antibiotic prophylaxis of animals at WRC;
3. Perform clinical examination and laboratory tests on newly retrieved and/or turned over wild animals at WRC;
4. Recommend and administer treatment measures for sick WRC animals;
5. Perform post-mortem examination on animal mortalities at WRC;
6. Assist in animal rescue and retrieval operations as necessary;
7. Provide veterinary assistance to other wildlife centers managed by PAWB as may be requested by the concerned officer/s;
8. Act as WRC Veterinarian in the absence of the Resident Veterinarian of said Center;
9. Submit regular/monthly accomplishment reports to the PAWB Director through proper channel; and

10. Perform other tasks that may be assigned by the In-Charge, WRC and/or higher authorities from time to time.
